There are four issues I would like addressed.


#### 1. TIME OF RESPONSE

As per Sheet #1, the time for response to a request under ATTIPA is 30 days. Why is it that the Agency usually takes the full 30 days to respond and sometimes an additional day or two (my experience)? This is understandable if the request is complex and time consuming but I have experienced the 30 day limit when I have requested a copy of a letter, naming the sender, recipient and date.

I get the impression that the applicant is being punished for requesting the information.

#### 2. REDACTING INFORMATION

Redacting is a choice action in response to requests under ATIPPA. See Attached Sheet #2. I requested any and all information about/pertaining/concerning me. If the correspondence is about/pertaining/concerning me, why is so much redacted? Who decides what is about/concerns/pertains to me? The ATTIPP Act Request Form allows one to request Personal Information. Then how can Personal Information be redacted?

- Make only one request on each application form
- Describe the records or information you are seeking in as much detail as possible
- Enclose a cheque or money order for the \$5.00 application fee payable to the public body to which the request is submitted (or, if a government department, payable to the Newfoundland Exchequer)
- Send or deliver this form and the fee to the Access and Privacy Coordinator of the public body most likely to have the records you are seeking
- Keep a copy for your records
- Please note that under authority of section 68 of the *Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act (ATIPPA)* you may be asked to pay certain additional costs as prescribed by the Minister responsible for the *ATIPPA*, before gaining access to records. If the estimated costs of a request for general information are more than \$50, you will be sent an Estimate of Costs and a request to pay a 50% deposit.
- Please note that if the public body does not respond within 30 days of receipt of this application, you may ask for a review by the Information and Privacy Commissioner, under authority of section 43 of the ATIPPA, or you may appeal to the Supreme Court Trial Division. In addition, if the public body extends this 30-day time period under subsection 16(1), you may make a complaint to the Information and Privacy Commissioner in accordance with section 44.
